Now more than ever, the Department of Radiology is so appreciative of its nurses and all that they are doing for our patients, their loved ones, and each other in light of the pandemic.




We would like to recognize **Jeff Weinstein, MD, FSIR**, for

For those unfamiliar with Dr. Simon's legacy, he was born in Johannesburg, South Africa, and received his MB, BCh, at Witwatersrand University and Medical School in 1948. He then completed a fellowship with the Faculty of Radiology in England in 1956.

From there, he became a Radiology faculty member at Beth Israel Hospital in 1958 and remained here for 46 years until his passing in 2005. He served as acting chief of Radiology from 1960 to 1962 and then chief of Radiology from 1963 to 1970.
